Driven to victory by Stirling Moss in the 1958 Dutch, Portuguese and Moroccan Grand Prix, along with a 2nd place finish at the French Grand Prix and set three fastest lap records.

Stirling Moss' victory in the 1958 Moroccan Grand Prix resulted in Vanwall claiming the 1958 Formula One Constructors' World Championship.

The car that put Stirling Moss the closest to becoming a Formula One World Champion – losing out by just one point to Mike Hawthorn in the 1958 season.

Also raced by Tony Brooks at the 1958 Monaco Grand Prix, where it claimed pole position.

The last 'Teardrop' Vanwall built.
