Piquet achieved three top-five finishes in this particular chassis along with a further sixth and eighth place finishes.

The BT54 was the last model in Formula One to use an aluminium outer skin.

Powered by BMW's M12/13 engine, which produced 850 bhp.

The model which achieved Brabham's last win in Formula One and which gave Pirelli their first Grand Prix win since the days



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of Stirling Moss and the Vanwall.
