The car in which Niki Lauda competed in his last Grand Prix before retiring from Formula One for the first time.

Raced by Niki Lauda throughout most of the 1979 Formula One season, including at Monaco where he was running in third place before being taken out by Didier Pironi's Tyrrell.

The BT48 was Alfa Romeo's final year with Brabham and would be replaced by the Ford DFV in the subsequent BT49.
