The only unrestored Testa Rossa in existence, ex-Works car, 1958 race results include wins at the 12 Hours of Sebring and 1000 km Buenos Aires, 2nd at the Nürburgring 1000 km, 4th at the Targa Florio and the leading TR at Le Mans until a clutch failure that would propel its sister car to victory. The second prototype, raced by the most highly regarded, famous team drivers of the period, with its original engine, gearbox, chassis and body, it is arguably the very most important Ferrari in existence!
